Sub: Increase in the age of dependent son/unmarried daughter about admissibility of Family Pension

In terms of Para 26 of the West Bengal Non-Govt. Recognised Educational Institution. Employees (Death - cum - Retirement Benefit) Scheme, 1981 published under our no. 136-Edn. (B) dated 15.5 1985, the period during which family pension is admissible has been mentioned as (B) in the case of minor son until he attains the age of 18 years (c) in the case of un-married daughter until she attains the age of 21 years or marriage whichever is earlier.

- 2) In the meantime, Finance Deptt., pension Branch has, in its Notification No. 1097 -F (Pen.) dated 18.6.1991 has enhanced the said age limit in both the cases (b) & (c) to 25 years, subject to other terms and conditions e.g. marriage of unmarried daughter.
- 3) Accordingly the Governor is pleased to accord approval of the enhancement in age limit regarding the admissibility of Family Pension of dependent son and daughter of the deceased teacher and non-teaching employees of West Bengal Non-Govt. Recognised institution upto 25 years with immediate effect.

subject to other terms and conditions e.g. marriage of unmarried daughters.

- 4) The necessary enteries of Para 26 of the W.B. Non-Govt. Recognised Institution Employees (Death-cum-Retirement Benefit) Scheme, 1981 stands amended accordingly.
