MEMORANDUM

The erstwhile CPF optee employees of the Recognised Non-Government Aided Educational Institution (hereinafter referred to as the said category) since their switchover to Pension-Cum-Gratuity in terms of Govt. Order No. 749-SE(L) dt. 13.06.2014 are entitled to pension in accordance with law. Now a question is raised whether they can commute pension likewise other retired persons.

In clarification of aforesaid point, the undersigned is directed to say the Governor has been pleased to decide that the term pension includes commuted value of pension (vide Order No. 9203-F dated. 11.08.1999) and accordingly an employee of the said category who has been granted pension under court orders in terms of the aforesaid order is entitled to the benefit of commuted value of pension (CVP) as well in accordance with the provisions of the relevant DCRB Scheme.

This issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department vide their U.O. Group - P-1/2015-2016/0292 dated. 14.10.2015.
